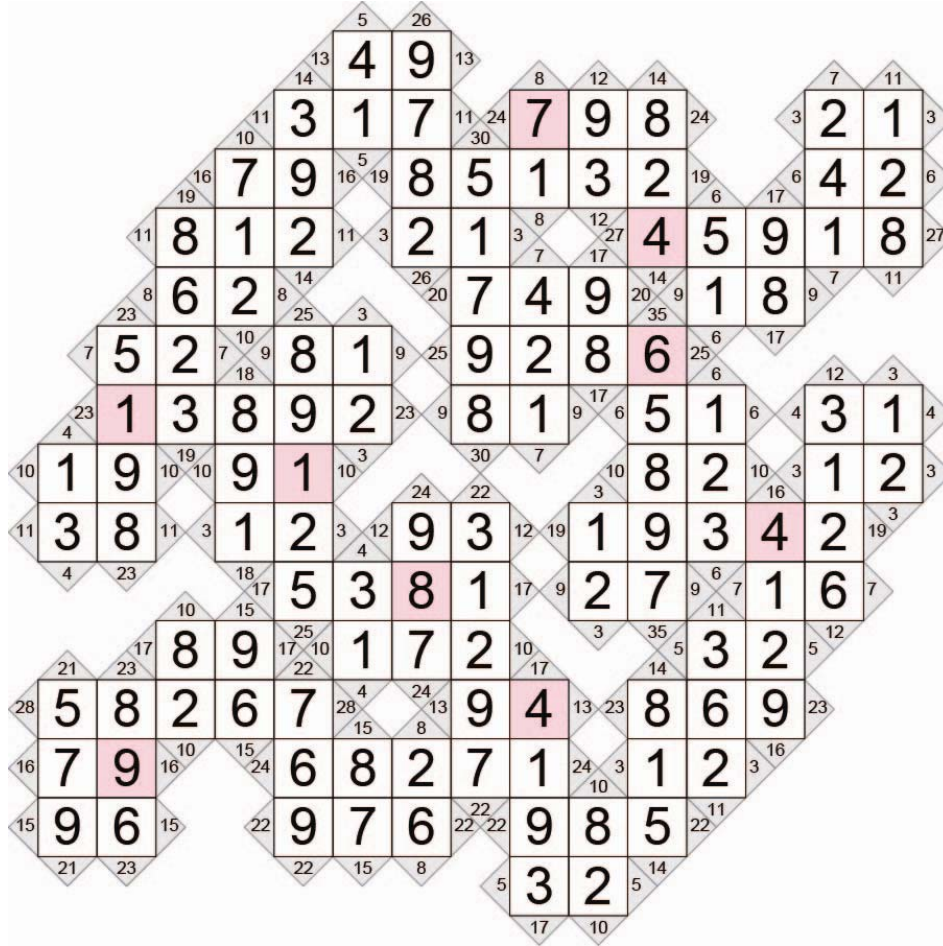




ICA 2014 Puzzle #3a

Kakuro Solution

Kakuro puzzles are a cross between a crossword and a Sudoku. Instead of letters, each block contains one of the digits 1 through 9. The same digit will never repeat within a word. If you add the digits in a word, the sum will be the number shown in the clue. Clues are shown on the left and right sides of “across” words, and on the top and bottom of “down” words.



1. After completing the puzzle, write the digits from the shaded boxes in the puzzle on the blank lines below. These numbers will be used in step 2.

2. Use the digits above to answer the questions related to traveling to and around Washington, D.C., the ICA 2014 host city.

- What is the distance in kilometers from Dulles International Airport (IAD) to the Washington Marriott Wardman Park hotel, site of ICA 2014? **46 km**
- How many minutes does it take to travel on the Metro, Washington, D.C.’s subway system, from the Woodley Park-Zoo station, the station closest to Marriott Wardman Park, to the Smithsonian station, the station closest to the Cherry Blossom Festival? **19 minutes**
- About how many hours does it take to travel by train from Washington, D.C. to New York City? **4 hours**
- About how many hours on average does it take to fly from Frankfurt, Germany to Washington, D.C.? **8 hours**
- You should have a few digits remaining. Enter the unused digits in descending order: **741**

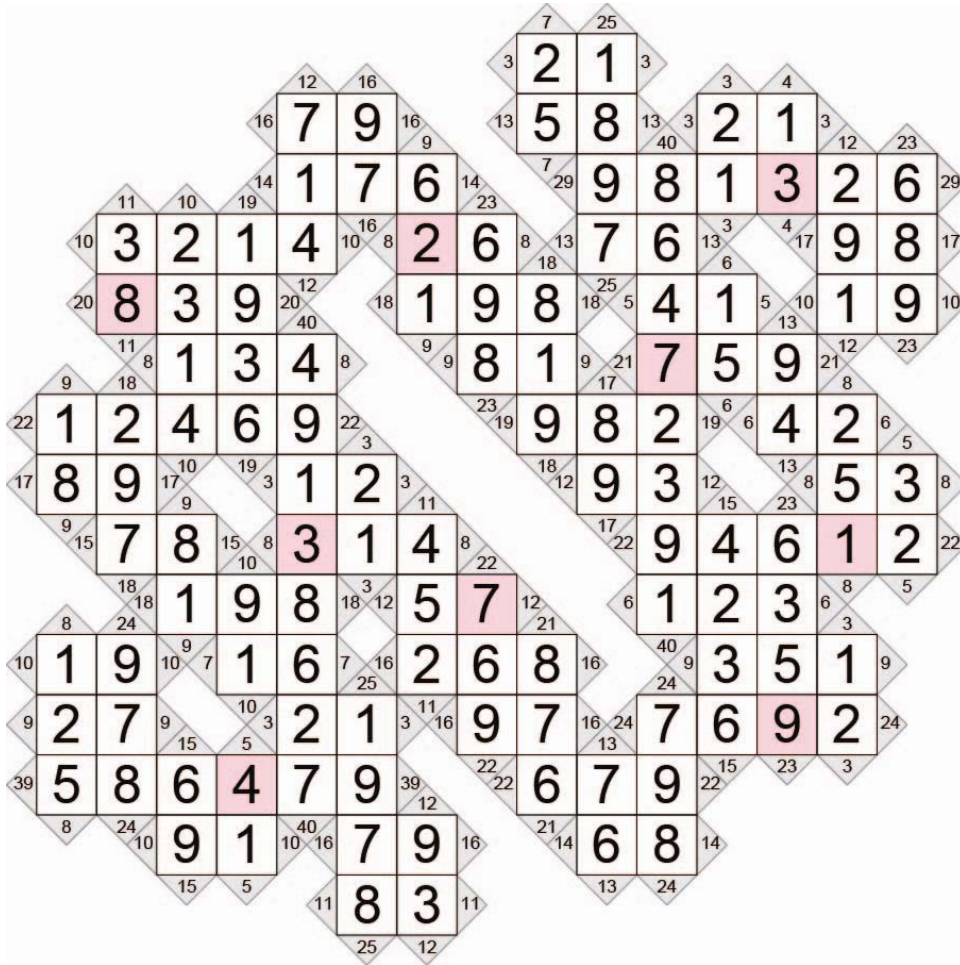

 - How many airports service the greater Washington, D.C. area? **3 airports**
 - About how many hours does it take to travel by train from Washington, D.C. to Philadelphia? **2 hours**
 - About how many hours on average does it take to fly from Mexico City to Washington, D.C.? **4 hours**
 - You should have a few digits remaining. Enter the unused digits in descending order: **9731**
